SIBL-BEMA SCHOLARSHIP

In conjunction with SIBL 40th Anniversary, \$155,500 was raised for a new SIBL-BEMA Scholarship. Thank you to all the donors for your generosity!

The SIBL-BEMA Scholarship aims to award scholarships to students in the Bachelor of Science (Project and Facilities Management) programme with a preference for Singapore citizens.

The Gift will establish scholarships valued at up to ten thousand Singapore Dollars (\$10,000) each, with the intention that at least one scholarship be awarded in each academic year subject to sufficiency of funds and/or available income from the Gift and the University's prevailing spending policies.

The capital sum of the endowed gifts will be preserved and invested to generate an annual income. The distributable income from the return of the investment of the endowed gifts will be applied towards the Gift Purpose.


